Remember, if you have a medical emergency, go to your nearest emergency room or call 911.

Primary Care When to schedule a primary care visit



- Annual checkups and immunizations
- Management of chronic conditions (ie: diabetes, high blood pressure, etc).
- Medications refills and medication management
- Follow up care after hospitalization and ER visits
- Common illnesses and minor infections

Urgent Care For care needed when your primary care is unavailable or the office is closed



- Sprains and broken bones
- Common illness and minor infections
- Skin conditions including boils, lacerations, cysts, and rashes
- Treatment for common infections (sinus, ear, urinary tract, strep throat, or cough)
- Work related injuries, sports physicals, and TB Testing
