

For Patients Waiting For Their COVID-19 Test Results, please remember:

- You have been seen in the Emergency Department and have been tested for Covid 19. Please quarantine yourself from all other people until your test results are known.
- If you test positive you need to continue to quarantine at home for 10 days.
- If you have respiratory symptoms, please buy a pulse oximeter and return to the Emergency Department for a consistent oxygen saturation of 89% or less.
- It is important to remain in quarantine until final results are received; please treat as if positive until proven otherwise
- Results can take up to 24 hours to be finalized and reported
- For your test results go to Patient Portal, please refrain from contacting the Emergency Department or Urgent Care seeking results.
- Results will read as “SARS CoV2 RNA”
 - “Not detected” is negative
- The Emergency Department is unable to provide a release / clearance to return to work note.
