FISH meets the temporary and emergency needs of the hungry, homeless, and under-employed of our community.

Services:

FISH provides the following services in rural Northern Nevada, in addition to many others.

- 3 Food Banks located in Carson City, Dayton, and Gardnerville
- Dining facility located in Carson City.
- The Ross Medical Clinic located in Carson City

In order to evaluate the emergency and/or temporary needs of each client, an in-person interview at the Fish center/office is the first step for anyone needing a "hand-up" during a time of need. No appointment is needed and clients are seen on a first-come, first-served basis.

The Community Essentials Emergency Food Bank is for any family who needs food during a crisis. Food is donated by local organizations wanting to help their neighbors. The Community Essentials Emergency Food Bank's purpose is community collaboration to assist others in obtaining fundamental items that improve quality of life.

Services:

When available, the center stocks perishable and non-perishable food, as well as hygiene items, and distributes them to the community free of charge.

There are no eligibility requirements

Please be sure to bring picture ID and proof of residency.

Donations are accepted year-round: Non-perishable food, toiletries, toilet paper, laundry soap, diapers, and more.

Carson City Senior Center

The Carson City Senior Center serves lunch daily in its dining room. At this time, we do not serve special dietary meals.

Services:

Reservations are not required for lunch. The first time you dine at the Carson City Senior Center, we ask some basic information so we can receive reimbursement for your meal. If you desire to eat there more than once, we issue you a scan card which helps us account for all of our meals.

The first Friday of every month, the Center celebrates those who have a birthday with a lovely meal. Ice cream and cake are also served. The oldest male and female celebrating their birthday are crowned *King* and *Queen* for the day.

The Food Closet is supported by donations from local individuals, churches, community service groups and business. Many food items are donated directly to the Food Closet while others are purchased through their partnership with the Food Bank of Northern Nevada.

Services:

Basic commodities are provided on a monthly basis to participating to supplement their food supply. They strive to provide participants with a variety of healthy food from each food group. In addition, they can assist with food vouchers to augment current food supply and do distribute food commodities to qualifying seniors at their site.
